**February 7** - Foundation of Faith - Now that we have “dug” the right heart foundation, rejoice that we have something to believe in... the Faith once delivered (Jude 3).

**February 14** - Foundation of Following - We must apply diligent faith to the Faith. We will emphasize the need for personal discipleship and accountability.

**February 21** - Foundation of Family (Home) - If our homes have no foundation of Faith, it doesn't really matter how attractive the furniture within...disaster is coming.

**February 28** - Foundation of Family (Church) – We will encourage and emphasize the family aspect of Gold Hill and the value of each person and individual talents. One good apple blesses the whole bunch.

**March 7** - Foundation of Forever (Home in Heaven) - This is where it all culminates...let's go!
